ACORN Clinic	\$67,035	1	Alachua County North Central	Support for its "Across the Generation Improving Women's Health" program. This program expands the Better Babies and Birth Outcomes Program.
Diabetes Coalition of St. Lucie Co., Inc.	\$50,000	1	Port St. Lucie St. Lucie County	Project will increase and further improve the health status of underserved African American and non-Hispanic black residents of St. Lucie County in the area of diabetes.
