



*Florida Blue’s ICD-10 Phase I testing consists of an ICD-9 and ICD-10 comparison process using clinical diagnosis scenarios provided on our website by provider specialty. Phase I ICD-10 testing is a self-service process conducted on-site at the provider’s office.*



## Steps to Phase I Testing & Clinical Scenarios:

- 1) **Select your specialty** from the table below to open and print your specialty Clinical Dx Scenario form (PDF). You must **print your scenario form in order to complete it**.
- 2) **Select clinical diagnosis scenarios** from the form for coding purposes.
- 3) **Instruct your medical coder(s) to complete the document** by coding your selected scenarios first using ICD-9 codes followed by ICD-10 codes. Be sure coder(s) understand to code in ICD-10 from the data in the clinical scenarios vs. “mapping” from ICD-9 to ICD-10.
- 4) **Using the ICD-10 materials, validate the coding by the coder to complete this learning exercise.**
